<b>Transportation Services During Inclement Weather</b>		1 of 2
<b>Transportation - Safety</b>	<b>Date</b> October 2005	<b>Revised</b> August 16, 2010
<b>Policy</b>	In the interest of student safety, the Sudbury Student Services Consortium may cancel student transportation services.	
<b>Operational Procedure</b>	<p>The Executive Director of the Sudbury Student Services Consortium, may cancel student transportation services (by route, by area or by entire jurisdiction) further to consultation with the school bus Operators, Environment Canada and other stakeholders may cancel student transportation.</p> <p>Should student transportation services be cancelled, the Directors of Education will make the decision as to whether schools will remain open.</p> <p>During inclement weather, parents/guardians are responsible to decide whether to send their child to the bus stop or to school.</p> <p><b><u>All Day Cancellation</u></b></p> <p>The Sudbury Student Services Consortium will relay the cancellation information to the media and school board communication contacts and to other key stakeholders.</p> <p>The Sudbury Student Services Consortium will post all cancellation and route delays on their website at <a href="http://www.businfo.ca">www.businfo.ca</a>.</p> <p>Where student transportation services are cancelled in the morning, this decision remains in effect for the entire school day. It is the responsibility of parents/guardians to provide transportation to and from school for their child when schools remain open.</p>	

**Early Dismissal**

A decision to dismiss students early or not will be made in consultation between the Executive Director of the Sudbury Student Services Consortium and the Directors of Education. If students are dismissed early, the schools are responsible for contacting parents.
